

**“HIS FACE WAS LIKE THE FACE OF AN ANGEL”**

ACTS 7:8-15

*Stephen was full of grace;*

**JOHN 1:14**

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

*Stephen was full of power, doing great works and signs;*

**ACTS 2:22**

...Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with mighty works and wonders and signs that God did through him in your midst...

*Stephen was full of wisdom;*

**MATTHEW 22:22, 33**

When they heard it, they marveled. And they left him and went away...And when the crowd heard it, they were astonished at his teaching.

**LUKE 21:14-15**

Settle it therefore in your minds not to meditate beforehand how to answer, for I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which none of your adversaries will be able to withstand or contradict.

*Stephen's enemies were instigated by his preaching;*

**LUKE 20:19**

The scribes and the chief priests sought to lay hands on him at that very hour, for they perceived that he had told this parable against them...

*Stephen was accused of blaspheming Moses and God;*

**MARK 14:64**

You have heard his blasphemy...

*The people were stirred up against Stephen;*

**MARK 15:11**

But the chief priests stirred up the crowd to have him release for them Barabbas instead.

*Stephen was arrested and tried in a false trial with false witnesses;*

**MATTHEW 26:59**

Now the chief priests and the whole council were seeking false testimony against Jesus that they might put him to death
