DANIEL 6

The Bible never has anything good to say about flattery;

PSALM 5:9

For there is no truth in their mouth; their inmost self is destruction; their throat is an open grave; they flatter with their tongue.

PROVERBS 26:28

A lying tongue hates its victims, and a flattering mouth works ruin.

Daniel fears God, not man;

ISAIAH 51:12

"I, I am he who comforts you; who are you that you are afraid of man who dies?"

Daniel has certainly read this;

JEREMIAH 32:27

"Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh. Is anything too hard for me?"

HEBREWS 12:5-6
